About The Charity

KIDZ'NGRIEF provides concurrent grief support for any child aged 3-18 who has lost a loved one to death. Therapists believe children know how to process grief if they are in a safe, supportive environment with other children in the same situation. KIDZ'NGRIEF does not provide psychotherapy, but offers support through art, games, stories, play and other activities to promote expression of feelings and thoughts, thus helping children adjust to the physical loss of their loved one. KIDZ'NGRIEF sponsors an annual grief camp, "Mikey's Camp" for grieving children which costs \$15,000 annually.

From 64 East (Richmond & points West)
Take Exit 250B (Ft. Eustis/Yorktown). Continue on Ft. Eustis Blvd. to Jefferson Ave. Turn left onto Jefferson Ave. and continue to Constitution Way. Turn right into Newport News Park onto Constitution Way. Follow signs to Shelter 19 & parking.

From 64 West (Virginia Beach/Norfolk & points east)
Take Exit 250B (Ft. Eustis/Yorktown). Turn left onto Jefferson Ave. Continue past Fort Eustis Blvd. Take next right into Newport News Park onto Constitution Way. Follow signs to Shelter 19 & parking.
